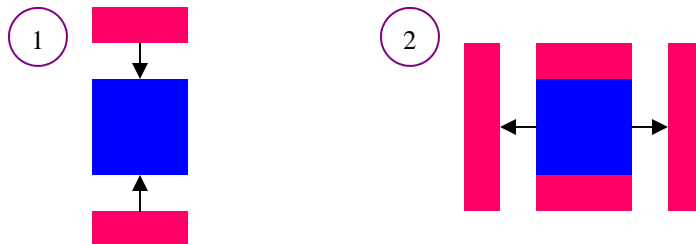

All Seams 1/4"
Finished Quilt = 68" x 78"
Finished Block for Quilt = 12"
Unfinished Block for Quilt = 12 1/2"

"Scrappy Memory Quilt" Fabric Requirements & Cuts

Fabric	Cut
Scrappy Fabrics	Cut (1) 8 1/2" square of EACH scrappy fabric you use, for a total of 30 squares
Jelly Roll Fabrics	Cut (2) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips from 30 Jelly Roll strips
Jelly Roll Fabrics	Cut (2) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips from 30 Jelly Roll strips
Border Fabric	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/4" x 72 1/2" strips
Border Fabric	Cut TWO (2) 4 1/4" x 68" strips
Binding Fabric	Cut enough 2 1/2" x WOF strips to piece together, which should go all the way around your quilt for the border.

 Finished Block for Quilt = 12"

"Scrappy Memory Quilt" Putting Your Quilt Together

Sew your rows together first. Then, sew the rows to each other. Once done, add the left and right border fabric strips and finally add the top and bottom border strips.

Once you have your quilt top completed, create your quilt sandwich and quilt in the way you choose.

Once you have quilted your quilt top, add your binding!
